Chapter 205

AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; REQUIRING THE USE OF STUDENT
IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS ON TRANSCRIPTS AND GENERAL EDUCATIONAL
DEVELOPMENT CERTIFICATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the Public School Code is
enacted to read:

"STUDENT IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS USED ON TRANSCRIPTS AND
GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT CERTIFICATES.--The state
identification number issued for each public school student
pursuant to Section 22-2C-11 NMSA 1978 shall be included on
each student's transcripts and on general educational
development certificates issued by the department."
