1 A JOINT RESOLUTION

2 APPROVING THE CESSION OF CONCURRENT LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION
3 TO THE UNITED STATES OVER CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN CURRY
4 COUNTY.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

7 Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 19-2-2
8 NMSA 1978, approval is granted to the cession of concurrent
9 legislative jurisdiction to the United States in accordance
10 with a like cession of concurrent jurisdiction by the United
11 States to the state of New Mexico for real property now owned
12 by the United States in Curry county, New Mexico, described as
13 follows:

14 A tract of land in the South one-half of Section 12,
15 Township 2 North, Range 34 East, New Mexico Principal
16 Meridian, described as follows:

17 Beginning at a point 60.0 feet North 89°38'
18 West from the East 1/4 corner of said Section 12;
19 thence North 89°38' West 1068.0 feet; thence South
20 0°12' West 1846.47 feet; thence North 88°17' West
21 708.69 feet; thence South 0°12' West 600.00 feet to
22 a point on the North right-of-way line of U.S.
23 Highway No. 60 and No. 84; thence South 88°17' East
24 1713.19 feet; thence North 45°0' East 90.6 feet;
25 thence North 0°12' East 2405.66 feet to the point

1 of beginning, containing 70.00 acres, more or less;
2 and

3 A tract of land in the South one-half of Section 12,
4 Township 2 North, Range 34 East, New Mexico Principal
5 Meridian, described as follows:

6 Beginning at the Southeast corner of said
7 Section 12, thence North 0°12' East 2649.4 feet to
8 the East 1/4 corner of said Section 12; thence
9 North 89°38' West 60.0 feet; thence South 0°12'
10 West 2405.66 feet; thence South 45°00' West 90.6
11 feet; thence North 88°17' West 1713.19 feet; thence
12 North 0°12' East 600.0 feet; thence South 88°17'
13 East 708.69 feet; thence North 0°12' East 1846.47
14 feet; thence North 89°38' West 4162.4 feet; thence
15 South 0°13' West 1237.7 feet; thence South 89°38'
16 East 238.7 feet; thence South 0°13' West 208.7
17 feet; thence North 89°38' West 238.7 feet; thence
18 South 0°13' West 930.4 feet to the North right-of-
19 way line of the AT&SF Railroad; thence South 85°33'
20 East along the North right-of-way line of said
21 railroad to the point of intersection of said
22 right-of-way line and the South line of said
23 Section 12, a distance of 3821.85 feet; thence
24 South 89°37' East along the South line of Section
25 12 1479.74 feet to the point of beginning;

1 containing 238.6969 acres, more or less.

2 Section 2. As used in Section 1 of this resolution,
3 "concurrent legislative jurisdiction" means the vesting in the
4 state and the United States of all rights accorded a sovereign
5 with the broad qualification that such authority is held
6 concurrently over matters, including criminal laws, public
7 powers and tax laws, and that it is the parallel right of both
8 the state and the federal government to legislate with respect
9 to such land and persons present or residing on it, subject
10 only to the United States and state constitutional complaints.
