EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Chapter 79

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR DEVELOPMENT TRAINING; DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Five million dollars
(\$5,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
development training fund for expenditure in fiscal years 2010
and 2011 for a development training program providing
classroom and in-plant training to furnish qualified human
resources for certain new or expanding industries and
businesses in the state. Any unexpended or unencumbered
balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2011 shall revert
to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect
immediately.
