2 RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; AMENDING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL
3 IMPROVEMENTS ACT AND THE PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS ACT TO
4 REQUIRE CHARTER SCHOOLS TO REPORT ANTICIPATED AND ACTUAL
5 EXPENDITURES OF DISTRIBUTIONS MADE PURSUANT TO THOSE ACTS.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

8 SECTION 1. A new section of the Public School Capital
9 Improvements Act is enacted to read:

10 "EXPENDITURES BY CHARTER SCHOOLS--REPORTS TO
11 DEPARTMENT.--

12 A. No later than December 1 of each year, each
13 locally chartered or state-chartered charter school that
14 expects a state distribution or a distribution of property
15 taxes pursuant to the Public School Capital Improvements Act
16 during the next calendar year shall submit a report to the
17 department and its chartering authority showing the purposes
18 for which the expected distribution will be expended. The
19 department shall review the report and, no later than twenty
20 days after receiving the report, shall advise the charter
21 school if, in its opinion, the proposed expenditures are
22 consistent with law and shall provide a copy of the advice to
23 the local district.

24 B. No later than January 31 of each year, each
25 locally chartered or state-chartered charter school that

1 received a state distribution or a distribution of property
2 taxes pursuant to the Public School Capital Improvements Act
3 during the preceding calendar year shall submit a report to
4 the department and its chartering authority showing the
5 purposes for which the distribution was expended and the
6 amount expended for each purpose."

7 SECTION 2. A new section of the Public School Buildings
8 Act is enacted to read:


9 "EXPENDITURES BY CHARTER SCHOOLS--REPORTS TO
10 DEPARTMENT.--

11 A. No later than December 1 of each year, each
12 locally chartered or state-chartered charter school that
13 expects a distribution of property taxes pursuant to the
14 Public School Buildings Act during the next calendar year
15 shall submit a report to the department and its chartering
16 authority showing the purposes for which the expected
17 distribution will be expended. The department shall review
18 the report and, no later than twenty days after receiving the
19 report, shall advise the charter school if, in its opinion,
20 the proposed expenditures are consistent with law and shall
21 provide a copy of the advice to the local district.

22 B. No later than January 31 of each year, each
23 locally chartered or state-chartered charter school that
24 received a distribution of property taxes pursuant to the
25 Public School Buildings Act during the preceding calendar year

1 shall submit a report to the department and its chartering
2 authority showing the purposes for which the distribution was
3 expended and the amount expended for each purpose."


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
