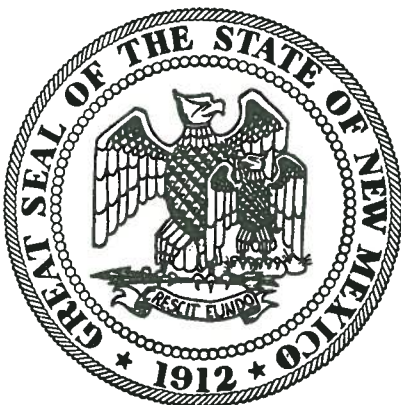

CHAPTER 24

AN ACT

1
2 RELATING TO FINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE
3 AUTHORITY TO MAKE LOANS OR GRANTS FROM THE WATER PROJECT FUND
4 FOR CERTAIN WATER PROJECTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

7 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF PROJECTS.--Pursuant to the
8 provisions of Section 72-4A-9 NMSA 1978, the legislature
9 authorizes the New Mexico finance authority to make loans or
10 grants from the water project fund to the following qualified
11 entities for the following qualifying water projects on terms
12 and conditions established by the water trust board and the
13 New Mexico finance authority:

- 14 1. to the acequia del Monte del Rio Chiquito in
15 Taos county for a flood prevention project;
- 16 2. to Los Alamos county for a flood prevention
17 project;
- 18 3. to the village of Cimarron in Colfax county for
19 a water conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse project;
- 20 4. to the town of Clayton in Union county for a
21 water conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse project;
- 22 5. to the city of Clovis in Curry county for a
23 water conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse project;
- 24 6. to the city of Hobbs in Lea county for a water
25 conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse project;

1 7. to the city of Las Vegas in San Miguel county
2 for a water conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse
3 project;

4 8. to the city of Lordsburg in Hidalgo county for
5 a water conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse project;

6 9. to Los Alamos county for a water conservation,
7 treatment, recycling or reuse project;

8 10. to the lower Rio Grande public water works
9 authority in Dona Ana county for a water conservation,
10 treatment, recycling or reuse project;

11 11. to the city of Rio Rancho in Sandoval county
12 for a water conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse
13 project;

14 12. to the town of Taos in Taos county for a water

20 restoration and management project;

21 45. to the Pueblo of Isleta for a watershed
22 restoration and management project;

23 46. to Santa Fe county for a watershed restoration
24 and management project;

25 47. to the city of Santa Fe in Santa Fe county for

1 a watershed restoration and management project;

2 48. to the Upper Hondo soil and water conservation
3 district in Lincoln county for a watershed restoration and
4 management project; and

5 49. to the Ute Creek soil and water conservation
6 district in Harding county for a watershed restoration and
7 management project.


8 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public

10 immediately. _____

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
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


