

2 RELATING TO INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS; REQUIRING PUBLISHERS OF
3 INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ON THE MULTIPLE LIST TO PROVIDE
4 INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT FOR ELECTRONIC
5 READERS BY THE 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR; RECONCILING MULTIPLE
6 AMENDMENTS TO THE SAME SECTION OF LAW IN LAWS 1993.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

9 SECTION 1. Section 22-15-13 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
10 Chapter 16, Section 217, as amended by Laws 1993, Chapter 156,
11 Section 6 and also by Laws 1993, Chapter 226, Section 44) is
12 amended to read:

13 "22-15-13. CONTRACTS WITH PUBLISHERS.--

14 A. The department may enter into a contract with a
15 publisher or a publisher's authorized agent for the purchase
16 and delivery of instructional material selected from the
17 multiple list adopted by the department.

18 B. Payment for instructional material purchased by
19 the department shall be made only upon performance of the
20 contract and the delivery and receipt of the instructional
21 material.

22 C. Each publisher or publisher's authorized agent
23 contracting with the state for the sale of instructional
24 material shall agree:

25 (1) to file a copy of each item of

1 instructional material to be furnished under the contract with
2 the department with a certificate attached identifying it as
3 an exact copy of the item of instructional material to be
4 furnished under the contract;

5 (2) that the instructional material
6 furnished pursuant to the contract shall be of the same
7 quality in regard to paper, binding, printing, illustrations,
8 subject matter and authorship as the copy filed with the
9 department; and

10 (3) that if instructional material under the
11 contract is sold elsewhere in the United States for a price
12 less than that agreed upon in the contract with the state, the
13 price to the state shall be reduced to the same amount.

14 D. Each contract executed for the acquisition of
15 instructional material shall include the right of the
16 department to transcribe and reproduce instructional material
17 in media appropriate for the use of students with visual
18 impairment who are unable to use instructional material in
19 conventional print and form. Publishers of adopted textbooks
20 also shall be required to provide those materials to the
21 department or its designated agent in an electronic format
22 specified by the department that is readily translatable into
23 Braille and also can be used for large print or speech access
24 within a time period specified by the department.
