# CHAPTER 49

AN ACT

1  
2 RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CHILD ABUSE  
3 INCIDENT TRAINING FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

6 SECTION 1. A new section of the Law Enforcement  
7 Training Act is enacted to read:


8 "CHILD ABUSE INCIDENT TRAINING.--Child abuse incident  
9 training shall be included in the curriculum of each basic  
10 law enforcement training class. Child abuse incident  
11 training shall be included as a component of in-service  
12 training each year for certified police officers."

13 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the  
14 provisions of this act is July 1, 2011. \_\_\_\_\_




