1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING THURSDAY, JANUARY 26, 2012, AS "SCHOOL NUTRITION
3 DAY" AT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

5 WHEREAS, school nutrition programs provided through the
6 national school lunch program and national school breakfast
7 program have provided millions of healthy and nutritious meals
8 to children across New Mexico for more than sixty years; and

9 WHEREAS, school nutrition programs play an important
10 role in helping to ensure that every student in New Mexico
11 starts school ready to learn, because a hungry or
12 undernourished child is less likely to be an eager and
13 attentive student; and


14 WHEREAS, school nutrition programs have demonstrated a
15 commitment in New Mexico to promote children's health, well-
16 being and educational excellence, a primary goal of student
17 success; and

18 WHEREAS, in New Mexico, two hundred three public,
19 private and bureau of Indian affairs school districts serve
20 more than two hundred sixty-six thousand lunches and one
21 hundred forty-five thousand breakfast meals each school day;

24 participating in school breakfast programs in the United
