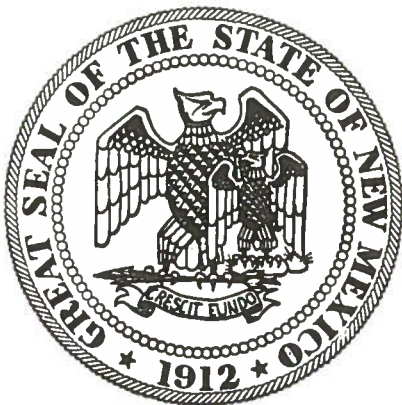

2 RECOGNIZING THE LIFE AND CONTRIBUTIONS OF ROBERT M. HAWK.

4 WHEREAS, Robert M. Hawk was born in Purcell, Oklahoma,
5 on November 13, 1924 and passed away on June 7, 2011; and

6 WHEREAS, Robert M. Hawk moved to Albuquerque, New
7 Mexico, in 1946, and he graduated from the university of New
8 Mexico; and

9 WHEREAS, upon his retirement from Sandia national
10 laboratories, he dedicated himself to serving the community of
11 Albuquerque and the state of New Mexico in many ways; and

12 WHEREAS, Robert M. Hawk served on various boards,
13 including the board of New Mexico's state psychiatric
14 hospital, the board of trustees of the university of New
15 Mexico hospitals and the advisory board of the Sequoyah
16 adolescent treatment center; and

17 WHEREAS, he was called to public service and served for
18 six years as a Bernalillo county commissioner and for fourteen
19 years as a New Mexico state representative; and

20 WHEREAS, during his time in the legislature,
21 Representative Hawk championed mental health issues,
22 particularly those involving children, and he sponsored major
23 legislation to address the issue of driving while intoxicated,
24 legislation which has saved thousands of lives; and

25 WHEREAS, Representative Hawk chaired the house taxation

1 and revenue committee from 1991 to 1994 and, with
2 uncompromising ethics, was a steadfast steward of the state
3 budget and tax revenues; and

4 WHEREAS, he also served on various other standing
5 committees, including the appropriations and finance
6 committee, the consumer and public affairs committee and the
7 labor and human resources committee; and

8 WHEREAS, through his extensive public service and
9 community involvement, Robert M. Hawk lived a life that served
10 as an inspiration to others of the joy of service to one's
11 community;


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
