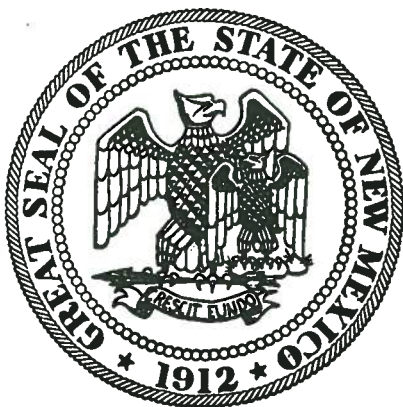

1 A MEMORIAL

2 PROCLAIMING FEBRUARY 15, 2012 AS "NEW MEXICO SPEECH-LANGUAGE
3 AND HEARING ASSOCIATION DAY" AT THE SENATE.

7 untreated, can present significant obstacles to academic
8 achievement, social adjustment and career advancement; and

11 disorders to lead independent, productive and fulfilling
12 lives; and

13 WHEREAS, audiologists and speech-language pathologists
14 work to eliminate or minimize the isolating effects of
15 communication disorders on affected families; and

16 WHEREAS, audiologists and speech-language pathologists
17 offer quality education and health care services to the
18 people of New Mexico; and

19 WHEREAS, the New Mexico speech-language and hearing
20 association is a statewide professional body of
21 speech-language pathologists and audiologists with a mission
22 of providing the highest quality of support services;


23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE

3 the state for their valuable service; and


4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
