2 RELATING TO DRIVER'S EDUCATION; REDUCING TO FIFTY YEARS OLD
3 THE MINIMUM AGE OF COURSE PARTICIPANTS FOR CERTAIN DRIVER'S
4 EDUCATION COURSES TO BE EXEMPT FROM THE DRIVING SCHOOL
5 LICENSING ACT.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

8 SECTION 1. Section 66-10-12 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
9 Chapter 68, Section 55) is amended to read:

10 "66-10-12. EXEMPT PROVIDERS.--The Driving School
11 Licensing Act shall not apply to nonprofit corporations that
12 provide motor vehicle accident prevention courses approved by
13 the traffic safety bureau of the department of transportation
14 and that are engaged in providing courses exclusively for
15 drivers who are fifty years of age or older."

16 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
17 provisions of this act is July 1, 2015. _____


