CHAPTER 85

AN ACT

2 RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING; PROVIDING FOR BARBER
3 LICENSURE AFTER COMPLETION OF A REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP
4 PROGRAM.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

7 SECTION 1. Section 61-17A-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
8 Chapter 171, Section 8, as amended) is amended to read:

9 "61-17A-8. LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS--BARBERS.--

10 A. Except as provided in Subsection B of this
11 section, a barber license shall be issued to any person who
12 files a completed application, accompanied by the required
13 fees and documentation, and who:

14 (1) has an education equivalent to the
15 completion of the second year of high school;

16 (2) is at least seventeen years of age;

17 (3) has completed a course in barbering of
18 at least one thousand two hundred hours in a school or
19 apprenticeship approved by the board; and

20 (4) has passed an examination approved by
21 the board.


22 B. A barbering license shall be issued to a person
23 who files a completed application, accompanied by the required
24 fees and documentation, meets the requirements of Paragraphs
25 (1) through (4) of Subsection A of this section and shows


1 proof of having successfully completed a registered barbering
2 apprenticeship approved by the state apprenticeship agency and
3 the board of barbers and cosmetologists.


4 C. The holder of a barber license has the right
5 and privilege to use the title "barber", and the initials
6 "R.B." following the holder's surname and to use a barber
7 pole, the traditional striped, vertical emblem of the
8 barbering trade." _____


