2 HONORING REPRESENTATIVE BILL MCCAMLEY AND RECOGNIZING HIS
3 OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO NEW MEXICO.

5 WHEREAS, Representative Bill McCamley, a Democrat, will
6 be leaving office after serving three terms in the house of
7 representatives; and

8 WHEREAS, since 2013, Representative McCamley has
9 represented district 33, covering Dona Ana county; and

10 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is the chair of the
11 labor and economic development committee and a member of the
12 energy, environment and natural resources committee and the
13 rules and order of business committee; and

14 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is also the chair of
15 the interim New Mexico finance authority oversight committee;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, prior to serving in the legislature,
18 Representative McCamley was the youngest county commissioner
19 ever elected to the Dona Ana county commission, and he served
20 from 2004 to 2008; and

21 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley has passed bipartisan
22 legislation with Representative Candy Spence Ezzell for state
23 land remediation; and

24 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is a strong supporter
25 of clean energy; economic development, including along the

1 border with Mexico; legalizing cannabis for recreational use;
2 and fighting for a fair tax system; and

3 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is known for his sharp,
4 impassioned speeches when advocating for the causes he
5 supports; and

6 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley was born on a military
7 base in Pusan, South Korea, where his father was stationed in
8 the United States army; and

9 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is a graduate of
10 Mayfield high school in Las Cruces and received a bachelor of
11 arts degree in government from New Mexico state university in
12 2001 and a master of public policy degree from the John F.
13 Kennedy school of government at Harvard university in 2003;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley is a business outreach
16 director; and

17 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley's mother, Linda, and
18 sister, Maureen, support his endeavors; and


19 WHEREAS, Representative McCamley has very fond memories
