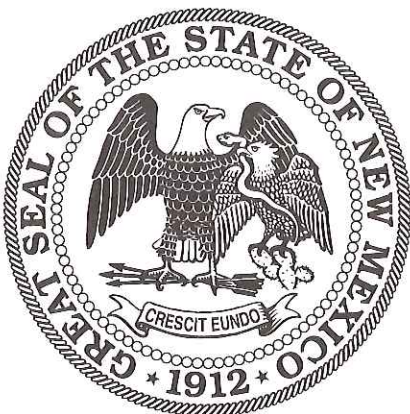

2 HONORING THE SACRIFICE AND SERVICES RENDERED BY GRANT COUNTY
3 AND OTHER NEW MEXICO WORLD WAR II VETERANS.

5 WHEREAS, on August 14, 1945, Japan formally surrendered,
6 ending World War II, the bloodiest conflict in human history;
