SOS Announces Absentee Voting and Other Election Information

SANTA FE – Pursuant to the requirements of Section 1-6-5(J) NMSA 1978, New Mexico Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver announced today that county clerks will begin sending absentee ballots on Tuesday, May 8 to voters who have successfully completed the absentee application process.

| Friday,
June 1 | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Last day for county clerks to send absentee ballots to voters. |
| Saturday,
June 2 | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Last day of countywide early voting. |
| Tuesday,
June 5 | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Primary Election Day.• Last day for voters to return an absentee ballot to their county clerk's office or an Election Day polling location. |
