**SOS Toulouse Oliver: Visit NMVote.org for
Last-Minute Primary Election Info**
Unofficial Election Results Will Be Available after 7 p.m.

SANTA FE – New Mexico Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse [encourages voters to visit NMVote.org](http://NMVote.org) – the state’s voter information portal – to find any last-minute Primary Election Day information they need, including their voting registration status, a list of voting locations in their county or their sample ballot. Secretary Toulouse Oliver launched NMVote.org in April so voters could find important voting and election information in a single location.

“NMVote.org is your election information hub – the place where you can find everything you need to know as you head to the polls today,” said Secretary Toulouse Oliver. “I want it to be easy as possible for people to find all relevant election information.”

In addition to important election information, today voters will find contact information for an Election Day Hotline that they may call until voting ends at 7 p.m. with any questions or concerns. The portal also contains links to direct voters to unofficial election results for all state and county races that are on the 2018 Primary Election ballot. Results will begin appearing on the Secretary of State’s website after voting ends at 7 p.m.

The Primary Election results are considered unofficial until the County Canvassing Board in each county and the State Canvassing Board – which by state law consists of the Secretary of State, the Governor, and the Chief Justice of the State Supreme Court – has certified the election results. The State Canvassing Board will meet to certify the 2018 Primary Election results on Tuesday, June 26, at which point the results will become official.
